



informed that there is a misunderstanding and that she needed to take the GPE. Stammer notes that the student is currently enrolled in a writing intensive this Spring semester. The student did not take advantage of the exam being offered.

Brown calls for a vote on the request of ZK30 to waive the entire GEAR. The board unanimously denied the waiver request of ZK30.

*Request 2:* Brown notes that NH31 provided an undated doctor's note stating that NH31 should be waived from the GPE, as well as all in person classes. The note states that she is undergoing treatment, and it interferes with the exam and her ability to commute to campus. However, the note does not say anything about potentially taking the GPE online. It is possible that the doctor is not aware that an online exam is an option. But nonetheless, this is the recommendation.

Wilkinson states that she has a note mentioning that she cannot take the exam in person, and should be noted with the BMAC office. Stammer states that the note does not have a date and this is concerning. Stammer further stresses why the student cannot take the exam online. Deutschman notes that the student has filed to graduate in summer 2023. To further investigate Estrada discovers that NH31 is registered for all online courses and one in person class. Baker reached out to contacts and found that NH31 is not registered with the BMAC office at this time. NH31 is also currently registered for a future online GPE without accommodations.

Brown calls for a vote of waiving NH31 GPE requirement. The GEAR committee unanimously denied NH31 waiver request.

Deepti makes a motion to allow NH31 to resubmit the waiver request after applying for BMAC accommodation. Wilkinson seconds the motion. The motion to resubmit the application with BMAC accommodation is unanimously approved.

*Request 3:* HI32 offers a note from a mental health care professional encouraging that she be excused from the GPE.
