- Still have 130 students on-campus
- Increased police patrols as much of campus is empty. Multiple attempted burglaries, and one burglary ended up in theft of computers in COB. The rest appear to have been foiled.
- Many students & alums working to create mask-shields and personal protective equipment for community
- Summer will be in alternative delivery still. No clear way to plan a face-to-face summer without taking unnecessary chances
- Planning face-to-face commencement, perhaps in November pending things are getting better and CA law says we can have that big of group
- Message from federal government that we will get \$40mil in federal aid—however, some money may be taken away via state government and other sources. \$20mil will be used for students.
- Speaking to city and VA about space offerings. We may offer some space to enable testing sites and other means of public health.
- CR/NC (credit/no-credit) memorandum went through Academic Senate yesterday that will hopefully ease the stress of students and faculty this semester
