

Asbestos and Lead Clearance Form

Asbestos and lead are present in CSULB building materials and constitute a potential health hazard if not properly managed prior to disturbance.

Staff and contractors are not permitted to disturb campus building construction materials or painted surfaces prior to EH&S review.

Disturbance is defined as scraping, grinding, cutting, drilling, sanding, encapsulating or any other activity that will cause the material matrix to become airborne.
